



A seventh consecutive weekly fall saw the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index decline by 224 points to the lowest level since June at 5,856. There were respective declines of \$1,500/day and \$3,000/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates to \$10,750/day and \$23,500/day.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
