



The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell by 1,463 points week-on-week to 12,614, although it remains elevated compared to the levels of recent years. There were falls of \$6,000/day and \$7,600/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates to a respective \$35,500/day and \$55,750/day.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
