



The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index climbed by a further 1,539 points in the past week to a six-week high of 12,732. The round-voyage and fronthaul rates rose by a respective \$9,250/day and \$6,250/day to reach \$35,500/day and \$55,000/day.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
