

ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell by 558 points to a five-week low of 11,842. There were declines of \$2,000/day and \$2,600/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates to \$32,250/day and \$53,750/day, respectively.
