



At 16,688 points, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index jumped 2,258 points in the week to 23 August, reaching the highest level since December 2009. Both the Atlantic round-voyage and fronthaul rate surged over the past seven days, up \$12,000/day and \$11,150/day to \$50,000/day and \$75,000/day, respectively.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
