



The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index climbed by a further 533 points week-on-week to 17,221, a level last reached in November 2009. There were increases of \$5,000/day and \$7,000/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates to \$55,000/day and \$82,000/day, respectively.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
