



A steep 1,158 point drop, the first weekly decline since July, took the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index to 16,063. There were falls of \$2,500/day and \$2,000/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates to \$52,500/day and \$80,000/day, respectively.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
