

ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index climbed by 1,790 points week-on-week to 13,710, rising above the year-ago level for the first time in six weeks. There were increases of \$6,000/day and \$9,750/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rate to \$23,250/day and \$49,250/day, respectively.
