

ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

After six weeks of climbing, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell 2,743 points to 12,633. The round-voyage and fronthaul rate declined by \$10,250/day and \$16,750/day to a respective \$22,000/day and \$45,000/day.
