

## **ATLANTIC**CAPESIZE INDEX

Changing direction for the fifth time in five weeks, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index dropped by 1,173 points week-on-week to 12,674. The round-voyage and fronthaul rates declined by \$5,500/day and \$3,650/day to a respective \$24,500/day and \$44,000/day.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
