



A further 1,108 point weekly gain saw the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index reach the highest level for eight weeks at 10,084. The round-voyage and fronthaul rates climbed by \$6,500/day and \$7,500/day to \$19,000/day and \$36,500/day, respectively.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
