



The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index dropped by 524 points week-on-week to 10,625. There were falls of \$1,400/day and \$2,600/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rate to \$25,250/day and \$37,250/day, respectively.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
