



The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index dropped by 608 points from last week to a two-week low of 8,036. There were decreases of \$3,150/day and \$1,100/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates to \$14,850/day and \$30,250/day, respectively.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
