

ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell 22 points on the week to 9,766. SSY's assessed fronthaul rate fell \$150/day to \$38,850/day, while the round-voyage increased \$3,000/day to \$22,500/day, the highest level year-to-date.
